When your RPM reaches about 2500 to 3000 while the car is in motion, it is time to shift to the next gear — for example, second gear if you are currently in first. Implement the speed shift technique for your manual transmission by revving your engine before your launch from 2000 to 3500 rpm, depending upon the low-end torque of your vehicle (the more torque you have, the less you will need to rev your engine). Remember that the less you spin your tires, the quicker your launch will be.

Manual mode- Indicated by solid red/green leds. This is traditional, full-manual shifting. Shift mode 1 (S1)- Indicated by both red and green leds flashing twice. The default S1 mode is semi-synchro: automatically shift the rear derailleur when you shift the front derailleur.

Most manual transmissions for cars allow the driver to select any gear ratio at any time, for example shifting from 2nd to 4th gear, or 5th to 3rd gear. However, sequential manual transmissions, which are commonly

used in motorcycles and racing cars, only allow the driver to select the next-higher or next-lower gear.

Transmission fluid lubricates the moving parts of your transmission. You should check your fluid every 30,000 to 60,000 miles in a manual transmission car. Failure to do so can cause your transmission fluid to become contaminated with bits of metal from the bearings, synchronizers and gears. This can make shifting difficult or impossible.

GM0240XS is a 4-way 2-position manual spool valve which can be used to reverse the direction of double acting cylinders, bi-directional motors, or rotary actuators. When the valve is in the neutral position and is not manually shifted, 4-way flow causes the actuator to operate in a single default direction.
